CSG - Andreas Lindberg took the floor to update us on where CSG is and to address goal setting for Bellport soccer starting at intramurals. It's more important that players feel part of the club, rather than part of the team, and this makes things easier when you must change the teams. Andreas goal is to continue to grow the club. Most trainers have gotten very good feedback, and those that have not have been addressed. CSG is recruiting new board need to decide where the club wants to be, and how we want to get there.
